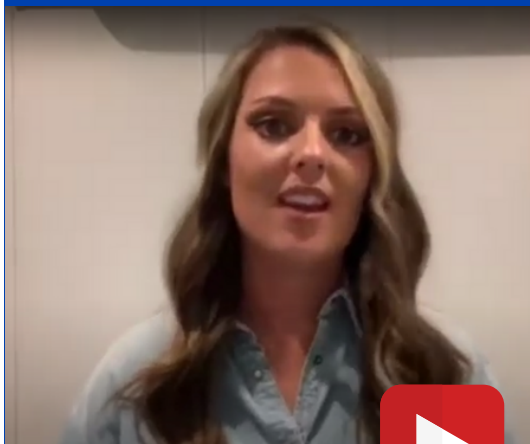
LIFE AS A CASTING PRODUCER
